

With respect to the merger of it.sa with the Dante Alighieri Society of South Australia Inc., the following terms and conditions have been agreed to by both it.sa members and the Committee of DA:

1. Sub committee of DA

- a. At the first meeting after the it.sa SGM and thereafter the first meeting after DA AGMs, the it.sa_sub-committee will internally elect a chair who will be a member of the DA committee.
- b. The sub-committee will plan and organize social and cultural events for the it.sa 'amici' and other interested persons.
- c. it.sa sub-committee meetings will be held on a regular basis or as required.
- d. The sub-committee chair or delegate will report to the monthly meetings of the DA committee or as required.

2. Membership

- a. New members of it.sa shall be asked to subscribe to the it.sa 'amici' by completing a membership form.
- b. Any existing members of it.sa under their previous constitution are automatically brought across to it.sa 'amici'
- c. Optional Dante membership at the concessional rate will be offered to all it.sa 'amici'.
- d. it.sa 'amici' will not have voting rights with DA unless they also become members of DA by paying the appropriate membership fee.

3. Finances

- a. All it.sa funds will be deposited in a nominated DA bank account and will be available for the continued use of the it.sa sub-committee.
- b. The it.sa sub-committee will present an annual plan of events with costings, or as required
- c. The it.sa sub-committee will cost its events at a profit or break even basis.
- d. All agreed upfront costs for it.sa events will be covered by DA funds.
- e. In the event that it.sa decides to re establish itself as an incorporated entity, DA will make available any remaining funds from the monies originally transferred from it.sa.

4. Record keeping

- a. Minutes will be kept of all it.sa sub committee meetings and made available to the next available DA committee meeting
- b. The Chair of the it.sa sub-committee shall present a profit and loss statement together with all receipts for every it.sa event to the earliest DA committee meeting after the it.sa event.

5. Information dissemination

- a. it.sa 'amici' will receive regular updates, invitations to events, and opportunity to participate in it.sa and DA events
- b. it.sa newsletters will be maintained by the it.sa sub-committee with cross promotion to DA members
- c. Until such time as an it.sa 'amici' page is created on the DA website, the it.sa sub-committee will continue to maintain a separate website with links to the DA website
